Yoshi Kawashima is President of YK Resources, his own consulting firm. He works as Senior Advisor to the Chemical Group of Mitsui & Co. (USA), Inc., New York, NY. Before forming his own company in 2002, he had been Chairman & CEO, Reichhold, Inc., Research Triangle Park, N.C. and DIC Imaging Products USA, Inc., Oak Creek, WI, from 1999 for three years.

A graduate of Tokyo University, Kawashima holds a Bachelor of Arts in law. He also attended Columbia University in New York and participated in the advanced management program at the Harvard School of Business in Boston.

Kawashima started his career with Mitsui in 1960 and worked in Osaka, London, Tokyo, Houston and New York. He retired from Mitsui in 1997, after serving as Executive Vice President, in charge of the chemical, energy, consumer products, provision and traffic divisions in New York for four years. He joined Dainippon Ink & Chemicals, Inc., which owned Reichhold, Inc. and DIC Imaging Products in the United States, in 1999. He also served on the Board of Georgia Gulf Corporation headquartered in Atlanta, GA, between 2003 and 2009.

He is currently a member of the board of director of the Mitsui USA Foundation and the International Advisory Board of Texas A&M University.
